Major PIP Law Changes

What You Need To Know To Protect Yourself

Florida's legislature passed major changes to Florida's Personal Injury Protection (PIP) laws. Florida law requires all vehicle drivers with a valid Florida license plate to carry PIP insurance, also known as Florida "No Fault"

The new laws favor insurance companies over the people who have been injured in a motor vehicle accident. Parts of the law took effect July 1, 2012, while other provisions will become effective January 1, 2013.

The major changes to the law include:

- You must seek approved medical care within 14 days from the date of the accident; otherwise no bills will be paid by your PIP carrier.
- Treatment must be from a physician, osteopath, dentist, physician's assistant or registered nurse practitioner.
- Only people diagnosed with an "emergency medical condition" will be eligible for the full \$10,000 PIP benefit. Non-emergency medical patients will be limited to \$2,500 in benefits.



- Chiropractic treatment will be limited to \$2,500 and must be referred by approved health care providers prior to treatment.
- Massage therapists and acupuncturists are not covered under PIP.
- Insurance companies are now permitted to conduct Examinations Under Oath (EUO) of their own insured's before any benefits will be paid.

While the new PIP Statute severely limits your rights to obtain your benefits under your PIP insurance, it is very important to seek immediate medical attention and consult with an experienced attorney to protect your legal rights.

Stacked or Unstacked?

What UM Coverage You Should Have

Uninsured or Underinsured Motorist coverage (UM / UIM) is not mandatory but provides protection to you, resident relatives, and passengers in your vehicle if involved in an accident with someone who has no liability coverage or not enough insurance to cover your damages.

UM coverage comes in two forms - "Stacked" or "Unstacked." Simply stated, "Stacked" multiplies your limits for this coverage by the number of cars you are insuring. For example, if you have 2 cars in your household and choose "Stacked" coverage, the UM benefit amount is multiplied by 2. Although this increases your premiums, the UM benefits double, thereby providing you with added

personal protection. Most important, Stacking allows you to expand UM/UIM insurance coverage for a loss if you are in a vehicle other than your own. "Unstacked" limits you to what is documented on the declarations page, regardless of the number of vehicles you own or have insured.

If you are getting a new policy or are about to renew your policy, remember to ask about "Stacked" UM coverage!

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Putting Profits Over People

Dangerous Drugs & Defective Medical Products

Prescriptions, over-the-counter medications and medical devices are used by millions of people worldwide and are intended to improve one's quality of life and even sustain life.



Whether you are watching TV, reading the newspaper, or reading your Twitter feed, there have been rashes of recalls leading to litigation and lawsuits

involving defective medical devices and pharmaceutical products.

While the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) requires medical devices

and drugs to complete some level of testing, an FDA loophole may be putting patient's lives at risk.



A current law allows manufacturers to "fast track" approval of new medical devices that may be similar to existing devices — even if the existing devices have been recalled from the market due to dangerous design defects. This approval process is called 510(k) Clearance.

Yet, with all of the testing the FDA requires, dangerous drugs and defective medical devices still are approved for use.

In an effort to reap profits, manufacturers often rush their products to the market and fail to sufficiently test the drug or medical device. Additional problems can include design defects, manufacturing defects, lack of quality control and contamination, faulty labeling, off-

> label use and unapproved usage, false marketing and promotion, lack of known warnings and undisclosed side effects, faulty packaging, and more.

Unfortunately, as long as profits are at stake, there will also always be some companies which are willing to forego certain safety advances in favor of profits. The injuries caused by defective medical products or by taking a dangerous or defective drug can be devastating, even deadly. If you or a loved one is suffering from the effects of a defective medical device or dangerous drug, seek medical attention immediately. Then contact an attorney to learn about your legal rights.

Reduce Your Risk Of An Airbag Injury

While the air bag has been an incredible safety device and has undoubtedly saved thousands of lives since its invention; it can also be a killer. The impact from an airbag can cause serious and permanent injuries and or even death.

- 1. Always wear your seatbelt
- 2. Move your seat back as far as you can while still being able to drive comfortably
- 3. Slightly recline the back of your seat without impairing your visibility
- 4. Tilt your steering wheel downward if you are able, which points the airbag at your chest and not your head and face



- 5. Keep children under the age of 12 in age and size appropriate cars seats and seat belts in the back seat
- 6. Never drive or ride with a child on your lap
